LEMON SISTEMI FOMALLY INVITED BY CAPACITA POWER INVESTMENTS LLC TO ACT, ON AN EXCLUSIVE BASIS, AS EPC FOR THE 450 MW SOLAR FARM PROJECT IN GUINEA CONAKRY

Balestrate (PA), 30th June 2025 – Lemon Sistemi (EGM: LS; "Lemon" or the "**Company**"), a company specialized in the design, supply, and installation of photovoltaic, thermohydraulic, storage systems, and in the design of solutions for energy efficiency, announces that it has been formally invited by Capacita Power Investments LLC ("**Capacita Power**") to act, on an exclusive basis, as the EPC Contractor for a 450 MW Solar Farm Photovoltaic Project in Guinea Conakry (Republic of Guinea).

The project is promoted by the Ministry of Energy and the Ministry of Finance of Guinea Conakry and will be supported by a sovereign guarantee through a concession agreement with the relevant governmental authorities. This framework is aimed at ensuring financial stability, bankability, and long-term investor confidence.

Capacita Power is a company with extensive experience in structuring and financing large-scale energy projects and it is led by the Saudi pioneer investor in the renewable energy sector, Salah Al Nasser; he has identified Lemon Sistemi as a strong and qualified partner for this initiative, based on its proven track record in delivering complex renewable energy infrastructure.

Based on the Engagement Letter signed today, the parties will arrange meetings as soon as possible to examine the technical, commercial, and contractual aspects of the potential collaboration. Therefore, in line with the current planning and preliminary discussions, the initiative is expected to be executable by the first half of 2026. The Board of Directors of Lemon Sistemi has approved, as of today, the signing of the Engagement Letter received on the same date.

Capacita Power, based in Dubai (United Arab Emirates), **is an international company active in the renewable energy sector, circular economy and sustainability**. **It manages 20 projects in North America, Africa, Asia and Europe, for a total value of approximately 1.6 billion dollars**, of which 12 dedicated to renewable energy and 8 to the circular economy. 11 projects are currently under development, such as a 500 MW solar thermal plant in Zambia and a PET recycling initiative in Ethiopia. 6 projects are nearing completion, including a solar plant in Guinea and waste-to-energy plants in Indonesia and Greece. Finally, 3 projects have already been completed, including a biogas plant in India, a tire recycling center in the United Arab Emirates and a water project in South Africa. The company has already delivered a 50 million dollar infrastructure, confirming its execution strength and global presence in the field of sustainable infrastructure.

"We are honored to be considered for this strategic renewable energy initiative in West Africa," said Danilo Palazzolo, co-CEO and CFO of Lemon Sistemi "This invitation represents a meaningful acknowledgement of our company's technical capabilities and long-standing commitment to sustainability in the renewable energy sector.
